[Nick's 114 Café](#) is located @ 114 Bridge Street in the small town of New Cumberland, PA, just south of Harrisburg on the west side of the Susquehanna River. It is the kind of place that you may not give a second glance when passing, but once you have tasted their food and enjoyed their warm and welcoming service, they will not be able to keep you away. They have a full bar, six pool tables and a few arcade games as well as great tunes.
